All digital projects may be completed traditionally on paper, but requirements and grading may be different. Ask if you have questions.

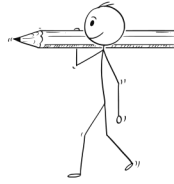
## SKETCHBOOKS

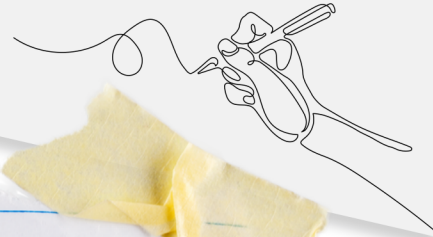

## BEST EFFORT

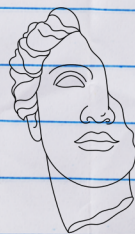

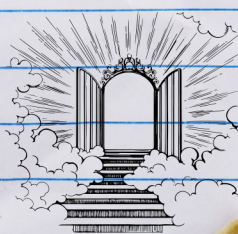
